Purpose: Increase marketing efforts to Medicaid and 3rd party insurers

in order to increase revenues and sustain program services.

Measures: 1. Number of New Insured Clients

2. Number of New Referral Source Contacts

Changes Made: 1. Enroll uninsured to outpatient / residential

2. Enroll Medicaid / Blue Cross Residential then Outpatient

Challenges: Longer stays, more complicated client cases

Successes: Increased insured clients by 250%

Impact of Project: 1. Increased revenue / Increased Program Sustainability

2. Increased opportunity to expand staff skills

3. Increased value of program to the community

Current Status of Change:

- 1. Initiated and maintained in Residential Program
- 2. Change is being spread to two outpatient Programs
- 3. Change Leader and Program Director monitor / maintain change through weekly census review

Future Goals:

- 1. Train intake staff to use the electronic screening tool
- 2. Develop "pre-screening" tool with decreased number of questions
- 3. Increase Medicaid and 3rd Party referrals to outpatient substance abuse treatment services from NRI's Community Support Program
