

Percent Continuation from 1st to 4th Treatment after Admission at (999) ACME Treatment Agency

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Report Description:

About NIATx

This report is part of a group called the NIATx (Network for the Improvement of Addiction Treatment) Reports. NIATx works with addiction treatment providers to make more efficient use of their capacity and shares strategies for improving treatment access and retention. NIATx works with its member organizations and the field at large to improve treatment through organizational changes that address four aims:

1. To reduce the wait time between a client's first request for service and the first treatment session
2. To reduce client no-shows
3. To increase addiction treatment centers' admissions
4. To increase the treatment continuation rate between the first and the fourth treatment sessions

Current Report

The current report presents the aim of increased continuation for consumers entering **outpatient** treatment. The objective of this measure is to determine the percentage of consumers who were assessed, admitted and had at least one post-admission treatment who continued on to have a fourth post-admission treatment. The information in this report is shown by month and broken out by satellite, age group and contract source.

Definitions

- Percent represents the percent of consumers who received one post-admission treatment within 30 days of admission that went on to receive four post-admission treatments within 30 days of admission.
$$\frac{\text{Count having 4th Treatment}}{\text{Count having 1st Treatment}} \times 100$$
- 1st Treatment represents the number of consumers who were assessed, admitted to outpatient treatment and then had at least one post-admission service within 30 days of admission
- 4th Treatment represents the number of consumers who were assessed, admitted to outpatient treatment and had at least four post-admission services within 30 days of admission
- Number of Treatments represents the number of episodes falling into each category of number of services within 30 days of admission. For example, the first column labeled "Same Day" represents a count of all episodes in which there was only one post-admission service within 30 days of admission.
- No Treatment represents the number of consumers who were assessed and admitted to outpatient treatment, but did not have a post-admission service within 30 days of admission.
- Average Treatments represents the average number of post-admission services within 30 days of admission per episode for a given month.
- Unique Persons represents the number of individual consumers that were included in all episodes.

Notes

If only one contract source has been billed, then "All Contract Sources" will not appear.

An episode consists of an assessment, admission and up to four post-admission treatment sessions within 30 days of admission that was not an assessment.

Drug Court clients have been excluded from the overall total for all contract sources because many agencies have court-imposed timelines and very little control over the admission process. However, data for the Drug Court contract source is included where there was a transaction type 27, admission and a first service under the Drug Court contract source.
