Storyboards at the Annual Meeting

All Grantee States will present storyboards at the annual meeting:

A storyboard is used to present a written message in a public setting and can be used to communicate, concisely, the progress and/or success of a project to different audiences.



Storyboards cont'd

Each storyboard should contain:

- Agency details
- Aims on which you focused, and changes your team made. Include graphs, data, and illustrations as appropriate.
- A brief statement about how NIATx has impacted your organization
- Sustainability and Spread plans
