This report is part of a group called the NIATx (Network for the Improvement of Addiction Treatment) Reports. NIATx works with addiction treatment providers to make more efficient use of their capacity and shares strategies for improving treatment access and retention. NIATx works with its member organizations and the field at large to improve treatment through organizational changes that address four aims:

- 1. To reduce the wait time between a client's first request for service and the first treatment session
- 2. To reduce client no-shows
- 3. To increase addiction treatment centers' admissions
- 4. To increase the treatment continuation rate between the first and the fourth treatment sessions

Current Report

The current report presents the aim of increasing admissions for consumers entering **outpatient** treatment. The objective of this measure is to determine the percent of assessments that became admissions. The information in this report is shown by month and broken out by satellite and age group.

Definitions

• Percent represents the percent of contacts that became assessments:

Count of Admissions

Count of Assessments x 100

- Assessments represents a count of all assessments for a given month. (Note: If a consumer had more than one assessment appointment before their admission, only the first assessment was counted.)
- Admissions represents a count of admissions that have an assessment within 30 days prior.
- Days to Admission represents the number of episodes falling into each category of length of time between assessment and admission. For example, the first column labeled "Same Day" represents a count of all episodes in which the assessment and admission occurred on the same day.
- No Admit indicates the number of assessments that were not followed by an admission within 30 days.
- Average Days represents the average number of days from assessment to admission for a given month in days.
- Unique Persons represents the number of individual consumers that were included in all episodes.
